WALKS&PATIOS

Clay Brick

Natural clay brick can offer a palette of color, style, and texture. Depending on the type and application, brick can be selected to have a formal appearance or more of a rustic salvaged look.

Concrete Pavers

Concrete pavers are a durable choice for withstanding environmental and human traffic impacts. Pavers are manufactured to resemble brick, tile, and even stone. There is a variety of colors and shapes to choose from, but even then pavers can be laid in several different patterns depending on the product chosen.

Flagstone: walks & patios

Flagstone is a great way to incorporate natural charm into a landscape. Common colors include greys, tans, browns, and reds. Flagstone is available as irregular, random size stones or more precisely cut tiles that are square and rectangular shapes.

Decorative Gravel Paths

Loose gravels are great for meandering paths through the landscape, great for cottage gardens and a natural appearance. A significant benefit for a gravel walk over the other types is that it is the most economical to construct.

WALLS

Freestanding Walls

Contour Landscaping offers walls constructed of natural stone or segmental concrete blocks. A freestanding wall can give the appearance of both permanence and prestige to almost any landscape.

Retaining Walls

Retaining walls can be a great choice to prevent soil erosion and to create a more functional outdoor area. The material types installed by Contour Landscaping are the following:

NATURAL STONE:

A natural stone wall has distinct character that cannot be replicated by any of the other wall choices. The craftsmanship involved in creating a natural stone wall will set it apart from any other. Since a natural stone wall is piece by piece hand fitted, it is therefore the most expensive of the wall choices to construct.

SEGMENTAL CONCRETE BLOCKS:

With always expanding product lines by many different manufacturers, this type of wall system has many different style and color choices. Since these types of walls are segmental, construction time is much faster than a natural stone wall.

WOOD TIMBERS:

A timber wall is often constructed from 6"x6" pressure treated lumber. The timbers are treated to increase longevity of the timbers by inhibiting rot and insect damage. Typically a wood timber wall is the most economical to construct of the three wall types.
